Item No: 2.1. To approve the <u>Resolutions of Board of studies</u> submitted by various departments.

MVS Govt. Degree College (A) Mahabubnagar, has 21 Departments offering conventional & restructured courses. Each department conducted its B.O.S. meeting to design the curriculum for 2021-22 Batch of students as per the U.G.C. guidelines of CBCS

The B.O.S has the following members.

- i) The Chairperson- the Head/In charge of concerned department.
- ii) Faculty from each specialization.
- iii) Expert in the subject from outside collges, nominated by Academic Council.
- iv) Expert nominated by the Vice Chancellor/Registrar, Palmaru University Mahbubnagar.
- v) Representative from the Industry, Professional academicians.
- vi) Post Graduate meritorious alumnus member, nominated by the Principal.

It is submitted for approval.

Item No: 2.2: To approve the <u>unit wise syllabus for I, II, III IV, V &VI Semesters</u> i.e., division of syllabus into Units for each Semester as per CBCS/ UGC guidelines.

All departments of the sciences subjects unit-wise their syllabus in each paper into 4 units for every semester according to the U.G.C. & C.B.C.S guidelines.

The departments of Arts, Business Administration and Commerce have unitwise syllabus in each subject into 5 units for every semester according to the UGC and CBCS rules.

All the departments of Sciences, Arts, Business Administration, Commerce and Sciences have unit-wise syllabus in each in every Skill enhancement Subjects into 2 units.

Every unit is to be managed 15 to 20 hours of instruction.

It is submitted for approval.

Item No: 2.3. To consider and approve the of Internal Assessments for 25 Marks in each Semester of under graduate courses. Two internal assessments in each Semester 20 marks each for 1st internal and 2nd internal assessments, and 5 marks for assignment/attendance/co-curricular/Extra Curricular.

The B.O.S of all departments resolved to conduct the Internal Assessment with Maximum of 25 marks in each semester of the U.G Courses. The marks are allocated in the following manner.

- Two Internal Assessments are to be conducted with 20 marks for each 1st Internal Assessment and 2nd Internal Assessment for I, II, III, IV, V& VI Semesters.
- Two Internal Assessments are to be conducted with 20 marks for each 1st Internal Assessment and 2nd Internal Assessment and taking the average of two internals.
- Two Internal Assessments is to be conducted with maximum of 20 marks for each 1st Internal Assessment and 2nd Internal Assessment for the Generic Elective (GE) for the V Semesters. And 5 marks for Assignment/ Attendance/Co-curricular/Extra-curricular Activities.
- There are no internal for Skill enhancement courses only theory exams are conducted.
- Project work is a special course and will be of 4 Credits. Project Work should be assigned to a group of 5 students and concerned subject teachers will be their mentor. Each project work of a student carries 100 marks total to fulfil the partial requirement for award of the degree at semester VI of undergraduate studies. Students should submit the project report in the form of dissertation which carries 75 marks. Evaluation of the project work is done by an External and Internal Examiners, Viva voce examination (Seminar presentation) is given by each student which carries 25Marks. One project work of 4 credits is to be completed. Group of 5 students can select any one of the three core subjects.
- The marks scored by the student in internal assessments are added to the final score along with the External marks.

Item No: 2.4. To approve the Question papers of each Semester End theory examinations for the Maximum marks of 75 with 3 hours' duration for optional subjects and 50 Marks with 2 hours for Ability Enhancement Compulsory Course and Skill Enhancement Course in each Semester, End Practical examinations for the Maximum marks of 50 with 3 hours' duration.

During lockdown the question paper pattern has been changed and it reduced to 2 hours with no change of marks with 50% chance for the academic years 2020-21.

And also due to pandemic the question paper pattern has been changed and it reduced to 3 hours with no change of marks with 50% chance for the I, III, V semester Examinations February-2022

The question paper Pattern for AECC and SEC have conducted with long Answers with to 2 hours without any difference in marks

A). SEMESTER END EXAMINATION (THEORY):

The Semester end theory Examination is conducted for Maximum marks of 75 with 3-hours duration and with minimum eligibility pass marks of 40% i.e. 30 marks. The marks obtained by the candidate in the Semester End Theory Exam and the marks obtained in the internal assessments are added. The student will be declared 'Pass' if the combined score is 40 or more.

The Semester end theory Examination for AECC & GE is conducted for Maximum marks of 50 with 2-hours duration and with minimum eligibility pass marks of 40% i.e. 20 marks. The student will be declared `Pass' if the combined score is 20 or more.

B). SEMESTER END EXAMINATION (PRACTICALS):-

The departments of Science and Commerce conduct Practical Examination for each Semester with a maximum of 50 marks, the candidate is declared pass if he/she scores at least 40% of marks i.e. 20 marks.

The B.O.S of each department has proposed a Panel of Examiners and question paper setters for each semester.

The M.V.S. Govt. Arts & Science College (Autonomous) has been introduced online evaluation process as per the instruction of CCE from the academic year 2021-2022 for the even semester end theory examination July-2022. And purchased barcode answer booklets for online evaluation.

- From the III Semester to IV Semester of the academic year 2020-21 onwards in each programme Two Skill Enhancement Course compulsory paper (Special subject with Maximum Marks 50) (SEC) offered by each Department is introduced as per the guidelines of the PU & UGC.
- For the V Semester students from academic year 2021-22 onwards in each programme Generic Elective (GE) Course compulsory paper (Special subject with Maximum Marks 100 with internal 25 Marks) (GE) offered by each Department is introduced as per the guidelines of the PU & UGC.

Moderation Rules

If the Percentage of Passes in a Particular Paper is less than 30.

1. In this case where the percentage of passes in a particular paper is less than 30 then

applied Moderation rules i.e., moderation marks of all the candidates who have appeared for that paper and secured at least one mark, as per the following norm.

- a. A Max mark of the paper is 50 or less, then moderation marks is 3 for particular subject.
- b. A Max mark of the paper is between 51 and 75 then, moderation marks is 4 for particular subject.
- c. A Max mark of the paper is above 75 then, moderation marks is 5 for particular subject (Not applicable to the present pattern)
- 2. After applying the moderation, if the percentage of students who have secured more than 55% in a paper is less than 70 then applied again the moderation rules i.e., moderation Marks to all the candidates who have appeared for that paper and secured at least one Mark, as per the following norm.
 - a. <u>A Max mark of the paper is 50 or less, then moderation marks is 3 for particular subject.</u>
 - b. A Max mark of the paper is between 51 and 75 then, moderation marks is 4 for particular subject.
 - d. A Max mark of the paper is 75 above then, moderation marks is 5 for particular subject (Not applicable to the present pattern)

If the Percentage of Passes in a Particular Paper is Greater Than or Equal to 30.

- 1. In this case where the percentage of students who have secured more than 55% in a paper is less than 70 then applied moderation rules i.e., moderation marks to all the candidates who have appeared for that paper and secured at least one mark, as per the following norm.
 - a. A Max mark of the paper is 50 or less, then moderation marks is 3 for particular subject.
 - b. A Max mark of the paper is between 51 and 75 then, moderation marks is 4 for particular subject.
 - A Max mark of the paper is above 75 then, moderation marks is 5 for particular subject (Not applicable to the present pattern)

Grace:

- 1. In Grace, adding 2 marks for a student who becomes passing in a paper.
- 2. If Papers going to be passing with the addition of 2 marks, then that type of paper is Applied grace in the following manner.
 - a. If Case 1. One paper going to be passing with 1 mark.
 - **Case 2.** Another paper going to pass with 1 mark. In such a situation, grace marks for case 1 and case 2 are applied.

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- b. If Case 1. One paper going to be passing with 1 mark.
 - Case 2. Another paper going to pass with 2 mark.

 In such a situation, grace marks are applied only for case 1
- c. If Case 1. One paper going to be passing with 2 mark.
 - Case 2. Another paper going to be with 2 marks.

 In such a situation, grace marks are applied only for case 1

 Note: Optional subject will be given priority.
- d. If Case 1. One paper going to be passing with 1 mark.
 - Case 2. Another paper going to pass with 1 mark.
 - Case 3. Another paper going to pass with 2 marks.

 In such a situation, grace marks for case 1 and case 2 are applied.
- Grace two marks can be added for pass/promotion/ reduction of Backlog/for higher division. This benefit will be given only at one stage.
- 4. 0.5% marks on the grand total can be added to any number of papers at that particular Appearance when the candidate is getting through the **Degree**.
